IV. APPROVAL OF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

V. REPORTS

- A. Financial and Budget Update (CRS) Community Resource of Colorado Ms. Sue Blair
 - June 2022 Financial Statement Sue Blair presented the June financial statements and reviewed with the Board the comparison of budget to actual revenue and expenditures. Total operational expenses are at 56% of budget. There were no expenditures from the contingency fund.

MOTION TO APPROVE THE JUNE 2022 FINANCIALS

It was moved by Jeff Shrader and seconded by Mike Weege to adopt the June 2022 financials. The motion was voted upon and carried unanimously.

- B. Executive Director Update
 - General Updates
 - Reminder the IDT vehicle is available for use. The trained staff will be taking the vehicle to all the agencies for a show and tell.
 - Hiring update applications are up for the summer. Jeffcom has created a new position for a Communication Specialist. The new position will answer only admin calls. The new Communication Specialist position will be a hybrid position, working 75% from home and 25% in the office. They will not be handling 911 calls and the starting pay is less than a 911 Emergency Communication Specialist (ECS) position. The process is currently underway, receiving applications and conducting interviews. The ECS process is also underway and are planning for an ECS academy September 26th, 2022. The academy for the new position will also start in September, with 3 weeks in the academy and 6 weeks on the job training. The new employees will work onsite initially at Jeffcom and then when they are comfortable will be able to start working remotely. There is the opportunity for growth if they wish to become a 911 call taker.
 - Jeffcom has 4 new hires in the current academy which started July 18th.
 - Mr. Streeter is hosting a Town Hall Zoom meeting tonight with the employees to give them an update on the organization and thank them for their hard work through the summer.

- The phone outage over the weekend was due to a ten year old router that failed on the fiber optic network. It was the backup connectivity for the Vesta. Jeffcom IT was able to quickly get that moved over to the new fiber optic network. There was not good documentation from 2017 as to the speed of the network. IT was able to configure the settings and Jeffcom once again has full redundancy. During this time calls were transferred to Denver 911.
- CISA will be conducting both an internal and external penetration test this year. CISA will be doing this free of cost thanks to a program they have for local government.
- Jeffcom IT has hosted a couple of out of state law and fire agencies showcasing our CAD through Central Square.
